3 **Resolution commending the Brotherhood Way Interfaith and Residential**  
4 **Community for their annual Vigil Service of Remembrance for Victims of War and**  
5 **Terrorism.**

6 WHEREAS, On September 11, 2002 the interfaith community along Brotherhood Way  
7 began an annual commemoration honoring the victims of the September 11, 2001 tragedies  
8 in New York City, Washington D.C., and Pennsylvania; and,

9 WHEREAS, Members of the interfaith community include St. Thomas More Catholic  
10 Church, Congregation Beth Israel Judea, Lake Merced Church of Christ, Calvary Armenian  
11 Congregational Church, and the Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Church; and,

12 WHEREAS, On September 10, 2007, the Brotherhood Way interfaith community was  
13 joined in their annual commemoration by the residential community of Brotherhood Way,  
14 namely the Alma Villa and Parkmerced communities; and,

15 WHEREAS, Each year, the commemoration ends with a candlelight walk down  
16 Brotherhood Wood, culminating at the Benny Buffano Statue in the Brotherhood Way Peace  
17 Park; and,

18 WHEREAS, This event is a true demonstration of the spirit of "Brotherhood Way" in  
19 that through the unity of prayer, various groups of all backgrounds can come together in  
20 peace; now, therefore be it,

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
22 commends the Brotherhood Way Interfaith and Residential Community for their annual Vigil  
23 Service of Remembrance for Victims of War and Terrorism.
