[Urging Governor Davis to appoint qualified lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender judges.]

Resolution urging Governor Gray Davis to combat homophobia in the judicial system by appointing qualified lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender Californians as judges.

WHEREAS, The Judicial Council of California recently completed a survey of 2,100 court users and 5,500 court employees that clearly demonstrates bias in our state's judicial system on the basis of sexual orientation; and

WHEREAS, This study uncovered that 56% of lesbian and gay respondents experienced or observed anti-gay actions or comments when sexual orientation was an issue, with those comments most frequently made by a lawyer or court employee; and,

WHEREAS, This study also documented that in those cases where sexual orientation became an issue, 56% of lesbian and gay court users did not want to state their sexual orientation and 38% felt threatened because of their sexual orientation; and,

WHEREAS, This study also found that 29% of court employees believe it is unsafe to be out in the workplace and 59% believe it would be better if lesbians and gay men were not open about their sexual orientation; and,

WHEREAS, One in five lesbian and gay court employees reported experiencing discrimination in the workplace based on their sexual orientation; and,

WHEREAS, A full copy of the report can be found on the web site of the Judicial Council at www.courtinfo.ca.gov; and,

WHEREAS, It is extremely important for lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender Californians to have equal access to the judicial system; and,

WHEREAS, Governor Gray Davis has yet to appoint open lesbian, gay, bisexual or transgender Californians to the bench in appreciable numbers; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges Governor Gray Davis to appoint qualified lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender Californians to the bench, and take all needed steps to ensure that all Californians have equal access to the judicial system; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors requests the Clerk of the Board forward this resolution to Governor Davis.
