WHEREAS, collection and reporting of data will also facilitate the development of better, non-discriminatory police practices; and therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco endorses Senate Bill 78 and urges Governor Davis to approve the bill to require this critically important data collection; and be it
