FURTHER MOVED, That the Budget and Legislative Analyst is hereby directed to initiate a performance audit in FY 2023-2024 of interdepartmental agreements including, but not limited to: (i) budgeting, recording of expenditures, billings and carryforwards; (ii) measurement and management of performance and adherence to contractual requirements; (iii) a comparison of the City's processes to best practices; (iv) a review of agreements for overbilling; and (v) the justifications used for the establishment of such agreements.
