3 **Resolution establishing permanent bicycle lanes on Valencia Street**

6 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Bicycle Plan recommends the striping of bicycle lanes
7 on Valencia Street; and,

8 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors supports environmentally cleaner modes of
9 transportation, including bicycling; and,

10 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors supports the establishment of traffic regulations
11 that promote the safety of the public, including bicyclists; and,

12 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors approved Resolution 892 establishing bicycle
13 lanes on Valencia Street on a one-year trial basis; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic has completed a report to the
15 Board of Supervisors Transportation and Land Use Committee on the impact of the bicycle
16 lanes on vehicular traffic, bicycle traffic, and pedestrian safety; and,

17 WHEREAS, Based on the findings of this report, the Department of Parking and Traffic
18 recommends permanently legislating the bicycle lanes; and,

19 WHEREAS, The Parking and Traffic Commission has approved Resolution No. ~~xxx-00-~~00174
20 PTC at its December 19, 2000 meeting recommending that the Board of Supervisors
21 establish permanent bicycle lanes on Valencia Street; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code and
24 the San Francisco Traffic Code, the Board of Supervisors enact the following regulation
25 governing the movement of vehicles as designated below:
