Resolution establishing permanent bicycle lanes on Valencia Street

WHEREAS. The San Francisco Bicycle Plan recommends the striping of bicycle lanes on Valencia Street; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors supports environmentally cleaner modes of transportation, including bicycling; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors supports the establishment of traffic regulations that promote the safety of the public, including bicyclists; and,

WHEREAS. The Board of Supervisors approved Resolution 892 establishing bicycle lanes on Valencia Street on a one-year trial basis; and,

WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic has completed a report to the Board of Supervisors Transportation and Land Use Committee on the impact of the bicycle lanes on vehicular traffic, bicycle traffic, and pedestrian safety; and,

WHEREAS, Based on the findings of this report, the Department of Parking and Traffic recommends permanently legislating the bicycle lanes; and, 00174

WHEREAS, The Parking and Traffic Commission has approved Resolution No. xxx-00-PTC at its December 19, 2000 meeting recommending that the Board of Supervisors establish permanent bicycle lanes on Valencia Street; now, therefore, be it
