7 WHEREAS, The Bay Area Air Quality Management District's  
8 Transportation Fund for Clean Air distributes funds to public  
9 agencies for projects that reduce motor vehicle emissions in  
10 accordance with the requirements of State law and the Air District's  
11 Bay Area 1997 Clean Air Plan; and,

12 WHEREAS, Bicycle facilities improvement projects are eligible  
13 for funding under the Transportation Fund for Clean Air; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Port of San Francisco desires to enhance bicycle  
15 parking facilities along San Francisco's waterfront by providing  
16 bicycle racks wherever a bicycle destination may occur, thereby  
17 encouraging the use of bicycles as an alternative form of  
18 transportation which will help reduce motor vehicle emissions; and,

19 WHEREAS, The Port of San Francisco submitted a funding proposal  
20 to the Transportation Fund for Clean Air to install bicycle racks to  
21 accommodate over 800 bicycles as the first phase in providing a  
22 network of secure bicycle parking facilities along the entire  
23 waterfront; and,




RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect cost in the grant budget; and be it




