11 WHEREAS, On May 4, 2002, all Miraloma Park residents, former residents, friends,  
12 and Miraloma school students and alumni will gather to celebrate the school’s 50<sup>th</sup>  
13 anniversary and to enjoy the annual Miraloma Spring Festival; and,

14 WHEREAS, The event commemorating the school’s anniversary has been in the  
15 planning process for well over a year; and,

16 WHEREAS, May 4, 2002 will be a day for the neighborhood of Miraloma Park to  
17 celebrate the neighborhood’s and school’s changes as well as what has stayed the same  
18 over the last 50 years; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
20 hereby proclaims May 4, 2002 as “Miraloma Elementary School Day” in the City and County  
21 of San Francisco in honor of the school’s 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary.


