[Authorizing the Office of Contract Administration to amend its contract with Xtech to exceed \$19 million.]

Resolution authorizing the Committee on Information Technology to enter into the Fourth Amendment between the City and Xtech (part of the Computer Store procurement vehicle), in \$25,000,000 which the amendment shall increase the contract amount of \$19,000,000 to/\$28,000,000.

WHEREAS the Committee on Information Technology and the Office of Contract Administration, by competitive bidding, developed the Computer Store procurement method for the purchase of products and services related to Information Technology; and,

WHEREAS, Xtech is one of eight vendors who are part of the Computer Store; and, WHEREAS, the original contract with Xtech was dated January 1, 2004; had a term of three years, through December 31, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the contract has been amended three times, by the First Amendment dated January 1, 2005; the Second Amendment dated February 11, 2005; and the Third Amendment dated February 28, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the original contract's not-to-exceed amount for compensation (found in Section 5 of the contract) was \$9,999,999, and Second Amendment to the contract's not-toexceed amount (found in Section 5 of the Third Amendment) was \$19,000,000, and that said amount has not been changed by any prior Amendment; and,

WHEREAS, the Committee on Information Technology and the Office of Contract Administration estimate that the money projected to be spent with Xtech could reach the contract's not-to-exceed compensation amount in the reasonably near future; and,

WHEREAS, Charter section 9.118, "Contract and Lease Limitations," subsection (b), requires Board of Supervisors approval of any contract estimated to exceed \$10 million in expenditures; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Office of Contract Administration to enter into Amendment 4 to the contract with Xtech; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that said Amendment shall increase the not-to-exceed \$25,000,000 compensation amount for the contract with Xtech from \$19,000,000 to \$28,000,000 million.
