WHEREAS, Dolores Park should serve San Francisco as a model for parks renovation, showing that even in parks where crime, drug trafficking and violence are reoccurring problems, parks in San Francisco can be reclaimed by communities through the hard work and successful collaboration of neighborhood groups, civic leaders and law enforcement; now, therefore, be it,
