THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND GIFTS OF \$490,692, \$280,588.14,
\$83,255.04, \$21,444.48, \$21,983.13, \$262,800, \$44,570.88, AND \$166,984.60
