17 WHEREAS, The OHMY Conference also serves to help teachers become advocates  
18 and form partnerships with LGBTQQ youth and help foster a school environment that is safe  
19 for all LGBTQQ students; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
21 recognizes OHMY for its continued support and effort on behalf of Bay Area LGBTQQ youth;

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San  
24 Francisco declares February 12, 2000 to be "OHMY Day".
