[GRANT-STATE FUNDS]

RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 101-98 AND RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND EXPEND FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$150,000 MADE AVAILABLE THROUGH THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE PLANNING (OCJP) FOR THE CONTINUED OPERATION OF THE "STATUTORY RAPE VERTICAL PROSECUTION PROGRAM" FOR THE TWELVE MONTH PERIOD FROM JULY 1, 1997 THROUGH JUNE 30, 1998.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 101-98, adopted by the Board of Supervisors retroactively authorizes the District Attorney of the City and County of San Francisco to apply for, accept and expend grant funds in the amount of \$150,000 made available through the Office of Criminal Justice Planning ("OCJP") for the continued operation of the Statutory Rape Vertical Prosecution Program for the period from August 9, 1997 through August 8, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the grant period dates reflected in Resolution No. 101-98 are incorrect and the correct grant period is July 1, 1997 through June 30, 1998; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors rescinds Resolution No. 101-98; and be it FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors retroactively authorizes the District Attorney to apply for, accept and expend on behalf of the City and County \$150,000 in funds made available through the Office of Criminal Justice Planning for the continued operation of the Statutory Rape Vertical Prosecution Program for the period from July 1, 1997 through June 30, 1998; and, be it

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FURTHER RESOLVED, That indirect costs to the City and County of San Francisco for the operation of this grant in the amount of \$7,500 have been included in the grant budget; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That state funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant local funds; and, be it,

FURTHER RESOLVED, That any liability arising out of the performance of this grant award contract including Civil Court actions for damages shall be the responsibility of the grantee and the authorizing agency. The State of California and OCJP disclaim responsibility for any such liability.
