[Public Works Code – Banners in the North of Market/Tenderloin CBD]

Ordinance amending Public Works Code Section 184.78 to allow the posting of banners in the North of Market/Tenderloin Community Benefit District as defined herein and adopting environmental findings.

Existing Law

The San Francisco Public Works Code Section 184.78 regulates the placement of banners on streets throughout San Francisco. Banners are prohibited in all residential districts except for RM-4 (residential-mixed high density) districts. The Board of Supervisors in Resolution No. 584-05 created the North of Market/Tenderloin Community Benefit District and established its boundaries. Residential districts exist within the boundaries of this District.

Amendments to Current Law

This legislation would allow the placement of banners in the residential zoned districts within the North of Market/Tenderloin Community Benefit District. The Ordinance also would allow the banners to be placed on the street face opposite the boundaries of this District. The legislation would adopt environmental findings.
