7 WHEREAS, the California Peace Prize, sponsored annually by The California
8 Wellness Foundation since 1993, honors individuals whose understanding efforts have
9 helped prevent violent deaths and injuries in communities across California; and,

10 WHEREAS, awardees of the California Peace Prize work tirelessly to prevent violence
11 and promote peace with little recognition outside their communities; and,

12 WHEREAS, each awardee is distinguished by his or her impressive personal and
13 professional accomplishments; and,

14 WHEREAS, the 2002 California Peace Prize awardee are Joseph A. Myers of
15 Petaluma, Raja Rahim of San Francisco and Wayne Sakamoto of San Diego; and,

16 WHEREAS, Raja is a survivor of domestic violence and abuse, brings together
17 multiple, service-providing systems to better serve families through the Greenbook Project;
18 now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors extend their highest
20 commendations to Raja Rahim and other 2002 California Peace Prize awardees for their
