3 **Resolution declaring June 19, 2003 SS Jeremiah O'Brien Day in celebration of the**
4 **60th birthday of the sole operational survivor of the 5,000 ship armada that stormed**
5 **Normandy Beachheads on D-Day.**

7 WHEREAS, The Liberty Ship SS Jeremiah O'Brien was built in 56 days in South
8 Portland, Maine and launched on June 19, 1943; and

9 WHEREAS, SS Jeremiah O'Brien made eleven voyages from the United Kingdom to
10 the beaches of Normandy for D-Day 1944; and

11 WHEREAS, In 1946, SS Jeremiah O'Brien was put into the "mothball" fleet at Suisan
12 Bay, California where she laid for the next thirty-three years; and

13 WHEREAS, In 1979, SS Jeremiah O'Brien was re-activated by a volunteer crew of
14 WW II Merchant Marine Veterans; and

15 WHEREAS, In June 6, 1994 the volunteer crew proudly steamed SS Jeremiah O'Brien
16 back to Normandy for the 50th anniversary of D-Day where she anchored off Omaha Beach
17 and welcomed many world leaders aboard, including President Clinton and the First Lady;
18 and

19 WHEREAS, On May 17, 2003, SS Jeremiah O'Brien received the distinguished
20 Maritime Heritage Award from the prestigious World Ship Trust; and

21 WHEREAS, SS Jeremiah O'Brien, a National Monument, is now berthed at Pier 45 in
22 San Francisco and lovingly maintained by a crew of skilled and dedicated volunteers; and

23 WHEREAS, SS Jeremiah O'Brien is a living memorial to merchant seamen
24 everywhere; now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors commends the
2 approximately 300 volunteers devoting countless hours to the preservation, maintenance and
3 operation of this grand old lady who is the last operational survivor of the D-Day invasion in
4 Normandy; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors does hereby
6 declare, June 19, 2003, SS Jeremiah O'Brien Day on the 60th birthday of the only Liberty
7 Ship in original configuration still sailing.
