Ordinance repealing sections 15.17 and 15.19 of the San Francisco Administrative Code, thereby dissolving the Drug Abuse Advisory Board and the City-Wide Alcoholism Advisory Board, respectively.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Findings.

WHEREAS, section 15.17 of the San Francisco Administrative Code established a "Drug Abuse Advisory Board" and section 15.19 of the San Francisco Administrative Code established a "City-Wide Alcoholism Advisory Board"; and

WHEREAS, Rule 2.27 of the Board of Supervisors' Rules of Order requires the Clerk of the Board to determine and identify each year every subordinate body that has not met for at least four months and to request the City Attorney to prepare legislation repealing the resolution or ordinance that created the body; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Board polled both of these subordinate bodies to determine whether they had met in the last four months and determined that the Drug Abuse Advisory Board was not responsive and the City-Wide Alcoholism Advisory Board had not met in the last five months.

Section 2. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by repealing Section 15.17 "Drug Abuse Advisory Board" and section 15.19 "City-Wide Alcoholism Advisory Board" in their entirety.
