Ordinance amending the San Francisco Administrative Code by amending Section 8.14, to adjust fees for services provided by the Medical Examiner, and to provide for annual adjustment of these fees to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending Section 8.14, to read as follows:

SEC. 8.14. MEDICAL EXAMINER'S FEES FOR COPIES OF DOCUMENTS AND CERTAIN SERVICES.

(a) The Medical Examiner is hereby authorized to charge fees to defray the cost of the issuance of the following mentioned documents and the providing of the following services.

Vieyor Brown BOARD OF SUPERVISORS No later than May 15th of each year, the Controller shall file a report with the Board of Supervisors reporting the fee new schedule and certifying that: (a) the fees produce sufficient revenue to support the costs of providing the services for which each fee is assessed, and (b) the fees do not produce revenue which is significantly more than the costs of providing the services for which each fee is assessed.

<u>(c)</u> All fees received for documents and services mentioned in this Section shall be deposited with the Treasurer and shall be used to defray the costs incurred by the Medical Examiner in issuing such documents or providing such services.
