Motion appointing Haregu Gaime, term ending June 6, 2012 and Melba Maldonado, term ending June 6, 2011, to the Immigrant Rights Commission, residency requirement waived.

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Immigrant Rights Commission, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 211-97, for the terms specified:

Haregu Gaime, seat 2, succeeding Gilberto Alexander, resigned, must have a demonstrated knowledge of and interest in the health, human service, educational, or employment issues that affect immigrants residing in San Francisco, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending June 6, 2012.

Melba Maldonado (residency requirement waived), seat 4, succeeding Christopher Punongbayan, term expired, must have a demonstrated knowledge of and interest in the health, human service, educational, or employment issues that affect immigrants residing in San Francisco, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending June 6, 2011.

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 1. The membership of the Immigrant Rights Commission has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- 2. Applicant Melba Maldonado, appointee, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the Immigrant Rights Commission.
- 3. The Immigrant Rights Commission has attempted to fill the position, for which Melba Maldonado was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so

at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Melba Maldonado is qualified to serve on the Immigrant Rights Commission.

4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is willing to serve on Immigrant Rights Commission at this time; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Melba Maldonado, as allowed in cases where no qualified City residents, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.

I am originally from El Paso, Texas, a border community defined both economically and socially by its relationship with northern Mexico. My mother's family immigrated to the United States from Guanajuato and Chihuahua and my experience and academic interests have inevitably been defined by growing up in a distinctly bi-racial home

I graduated from Stanford University in 2007 with honors in History and a minor in Political Science, focusing on international relations in both fields. I most recently attended Oxford University on a two-year English-Speaking Union Scholarship, earning a graduate degree in International Development with a dual emphasis in public health and the politics and economics of labor migration. At Oxford, I focused my research on U.S. immigration policies toward Mexico, working most closely with Dr. Stephen Castles and Dr. Martin Ruhs. I intend to apply to doctoral and law programs next year to continue working toward a career in international relations, focusing on the effects of U.S. foreign policy on the Mexican politics and economics.

I was born and raised in San Francisco. I have lived in the sunset district throughout my life. I am multilingual fluent in Cantonese and Mandarin. I also understand Hakka, Hokkien and some Toisan.

I have been helping the community since 2002. I was the president of the San Francisco LEOs club for a year, volunteering at On Lok once a month, spending time and doing activities with the elderly population. In nursing school as president of my Nursing Student Association, I coordinated blood drives and many community based events.

Growing up from an immigrant family I have seen and experienced the daily struggles immigrants have to push through. From the limited English comprehension to the direct or indirect racism that occurs to this population, I have, my entire life been closely involved with issues that immigrants face. As the eldest child in my family, I spent most of my school days translation and representing my parents as they did not speak or understand much English.

I am a nurse today because of my background and dedication to helping the immigrant population. As a nurse I see on a daily basis the confusion, frustration and devastation these people face not only in the health care world, but in their communities. Non-English speaking patients most likely will nod and say "yes" as healthcare professionals explain procedures and treatments in English without having a clue of what was just explained to them.

As a nurse I feel that I have the ability and power to change this situation. Many times I am used to translate and advocate for patients because of their limited English and knowledge of the medical jargon. I truly strongly feel a need for translators in the hospitals.

My aunt who just recently immigrated here was pregnant and unemployed. I helped her with all her paperwork and connected her to the appropriate resources to get her started. I feel that my experience growing the in an immigrant family and my professional career has more than prepared me to serve as a commissioner in the Immigrants Rights Commission.

### **Board Qualifications:**

The Immigrant Rights Commission consists of fifteen voting members. Eleven voting members are appointed by the Board of Supervisors. The other four voting members are appointed by the Mayor.

At least eight members shall be immigrants to the United States who are appointed in accordance with Section 4.101 of the Charter. The remaining members must have a demonstrated knowledge of and interest in the health, human service, educational, or employment issues that affect immigrants residing in San Francisco and shall reflect the geographic, ethic, and sexual orientation population of San Francisco.

The term of each member of the Commission shall be two years, provided however that the members first appointed shall, by lot, classify their terms so that eight members shall serve a term of three years and seven members shall serve a term of two years. In the event a vacancy occurs during the term of office of any member, a successor shall be appointed to complete the unexpired term of the office vacated in a manner similar to that for the initial member.

The Immigrant Rights Commission shall advise and make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor about issues affecting immigrants residing in San Francisco.

Report: The Commission shall render an annual written report pursuant to Ordinance No. 211-97.
