WHEREAS, The floods damaged historical relics in Hue, including several parts of the wall of Dai Noi (the Royal City), Thien Mu pagoda, the path leading to Minh Mang's tomb, Hon Chen temple, the Minh Kinh tower, Tu Duc's tomb and Thieu Tri tomb; and,

WHEREAS, Damages have been estimated at more than \$2.5 million; and,

WHEREAS, Vietnam is one of the world's poorest countries; and,

WHEREAS, Approximately 300,000 Bay Area residents have family ties to Vietnam; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco is deeply dishearten by the loss of life and injuries caused by the recent rains and floods; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors extends condolences, sympathy and concern to the flood victims in Central Vietnam and urges the residents of the City and County of San Francisco to participate in humanitarian aid efforts.
