Resolution requesting the City Controller's Office to conduct comprehensive surveys on the effect of any proposed and final health and human service budget cuts on San Franciscans receiving services from both faith and community-based non-profit contractors as well as City agencies, and on the alternatives to such services and the populations most affected by these service cuts.

WHEREAS, The proposed City Budget contemplated cuts to health and human services at historically unprecedented levels; and

WHEREAS, A significant portion of those cuts would have been in direct services provided lower income San Franciscans served by the City and faith and community-based non-profit contractors; and,

WHEREAS, It is reasonable to assume that budget shortfalls necessitating these or similar cuts will continue into the next fiscal year requiring future budget reductions; and,

WHEREAS, It is equally reasonable to assume that San Franciscans qualifying for these services will continue to need them regardless of budget reductions, and may well require alternatives to these reduced services; and,

WHEREAS, The scope and depth of such service reductions may exceed previous experience in this City; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors requests the City Controller's Office conduct a comprehensive survey on: the effect of any proposed and final budget cuts on the

number of San Franciscans receiving services provided by these nonprofit contracts, and on the scope and type of services available; the effect on the nonprofit contractors (such as facility and program closure, employee layoffs, etc.); the alternatives to these services sought by San Franciscans; the cost to the City, if any, of providing these alternative services; and the particular populations most affected by these proposed and final service cuts; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors requests the City Controller's Office conduct a similar comprehensive survey for City services; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller report these findings to the Board in a report due between six and nine months into the fiscal year and that this report be heard in a public hearing before the Finance Committee.
