

1 [Changing the Official Sidewalk Width along Portions of Illinois Street.]

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3 **Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1061 entitled “Regulating the Width of Sidewalks”**  
4 **by adding thereto Section No. 1563 to change the official sidewalk widths from the**  
5 **intersection of Illinois and 25<sup>th</sup> Streets to the intersection of Illinois and Cesar Chavez**  
6 **Streets; making findings pursuant to the General Plan and Planning Code Section**  
7 **101.1; and requiring relocation, modification, or both of facilities affected by the**  
8 **sidewalk width changes.**

12 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

13 Section 1. The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorporates by reference  
14 herein as though fully set forth the findings made by the Planning Department in its letters  
15 dated June 28, 2001 and April 22, 2004, which stated that the actions contemplated herein  
16 are consistent with the General Plan and in conformance with the Eighth Priority Policies of  
17 Planning Code Section 101.1. Copies of such letters are in the Clerk of the Board of  
18 Supervisors File No. \_\_\_\_\_.

19 Section 2. In accordance with the Department of Public Works’ Order No. 175,078, a  
20 copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. \_\_\_\_\_, Board of  
21 Supervisors Ordinance No. 1061, entitled “Regulating the Width of Sidewalks,” a copy of  
22 which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors Book of General Ordinances, in effect May  
23 11, 1910, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

24 Section 1563. The width of sidewalks from the intersection of Illinois and 25th Streets to the  
25 intersection of Illinois and Cesar Chavez Streets shall be as shown on Department of Public Works

1 drawing Q-20-544, a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File

3 Section 3. The Municipal Transportation Agency and the Port of San Francisco, as are  
4 necessary as a result of this Ordinance, shall make arrangements with public utility  
5 companies and City Departments concerning relocation, modification, or both of such public  
6 utility company facilities.
