Resolution urging Governor Gray Davis to support California's young children, working parents, and small and large businesses by ensuring continued funding for Stage III Child Care by signing AB4X.

WHEREAS. The Governor's proposal to eliminate Stage III Child Care subsidies affects 29,000 working families in California, including 55,000 young children; and

WHEREAS. In the next 16 months, nearly 2,200 children in working families in San Francisco will lose child care subsidies if Stage III Child Care is eliminated, at a cost to the City and County of more than \$10 million annually in subsidy dollars; and,

WHEREAS, Access to child care subsidies allows working families from diverse City neighborhoods to contribute to San Francisco's economic recovery by supporting their families and the City's small and large businesses; and

WHEREAS. Working parents transitioning from welfare have played by the rules and honored their contract with the State of California to achieve self-sufficiency; and

WHEREAS, Child care subsidies ensure continuity of care for young children, enables working parents to remain off welfare, and ensures incentives for low and moderate income child care providers to participate in California's child care subsidy system, and

WHEREAS. The California Legislature and the independent Legislative Analyst's Office have both stated their intent to prioritize child care for working families by preserving Stage III Child Care: now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges Governor Gray Davis to support California's young children, working parents, and small and large business by ensuring continued funding for Stage III Child Care by signing AB4X, and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors believes that support for working families to remain working is a policy priority to ensure economic vitality for the City and County of San Francisco.
