1 [Duboce Bikeway Mural]

2 COMMENDING THE DUBOCE BIKEWAY MURAL.

4 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has dedicated a two-block stretch
5 of Duboce Street connecting Market Street to Church Street as an exclusive pathway for
6 bicycles and wheelchairs; and,

7 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Bicycle Coalition, the Duboce Triangle Neighborhood
8 Association, Municipal Railway, advocates for the disabled, transportation improvement
9 activists, members of private industry, the federal government, and many San Francisco
10 citizens have embarked on a massive beautification effort to complement the Duboce
11 Bikeway; and,

12 WHEREAS, The focal point of the beautification effort is a 6,075 square foot mural
13 covering the back of the Safeway store adjacent to the Duboce Street MUNI metro tunnel
14 entrance; and,

15 ((WHEREAS, The Safeway store at Church and Market dedicated space and
16 substantial funding for the Duboce Bikeway Mural Project; and,))

17 WHEREAS, The mural was expertly designed by renowned San Francisco Academy of
18 Art graduate and local artist Mona Caron and painted by art team members Caron, Gordon
19 Dean, Bill Stender, Mary Anderson, Mike Rousseau, and Seth Damm, who were assisted by
20 over 50 volunteer artists; and,

21 WHEREAS, Bicycle Activist Joel Pomerantz worked tirelessly and effectively with
22 community groups, local and federal government, and the volunteer artists to coordinate the
23 creation of the mural; and,

1 WHEREAS, The details depicted on the Duboce Bikeway Mural represent some
2 important accomplishments of bicycle activists, such as the lessening of the negative impact s
3 of transportation on the environment and a more bike-friendly city transportation plan; and,

4 WHEREAS, The mural enhances the beauty of our city, promotes the bicycle for
5 everyday transportation, and proves government and activists can work together to improve
6 our city's common health and welfare; and,

7 WHEREAS, The Duboce Bikeway Mural was dedicated on Saturday, November 21,
8 1998; now, therefore, be it

9 RESOLVED, That The City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors
10 commends the creation and dedication of the Duboce Bikeway Mural and congratulates the
11 many individuals and organizations which cooperated to beautify our city and promote more
12 efficient public transportation.


