3 **Resolution amending all prior Public Assistance, Hazard Mitigation, or Pre-Disaster**
4 **Mitigation resolutions or any previous legislation pertaining to Public Law 93-288 as**
5 **amended by the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act of**
6 **1988 and/or the California Disaster Assistance Act to reflect the department’s name**
7 **change to the Department of Emergency Management and authorizing designated City**
8 **and County officials to execute and file on behalf of the City and County of San**
9 **Francisco, a public entity established under the laws of the State of California, any**
10 **applications necessary for the purpose of obtaining financial assistance.**

11 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has been the recipient of numerous
12 State and Federal grants to assist with various natural disasters through the Robert T.
13 Stafford Disaster Assistance Act and the California Disaster Assistance Act; and,

14 WHEREAS, A variety of departments within the City and County of San Francisco are
15 still in the process of obtaining reimbursement for these disasters; and,

16 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco recently changed the name of the
17 department receiving these reimbursements to the Department of Emergency Management;
18 and,

19 WHEREAS, The State of California requires that applicant’s agents be named in the
20 resolution, now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco, a
22 public entity established under the laws of the State of California, amend all prior Public
23 Assistance, Hazard Mitigation, or Pre-Disaster Mitigation resolutions or any previous
24 legislation pertaining to Public Law 93-288 as amended by the Robert T. Stafford Disaster
25 Relief and Emergency Assistance Act of 1988 and/or the California Disaster Assistance Act to

1 reflect the department's name change to the Department of Emergency Management; and be

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San
4 Francisco authorizes the Executive Director of the Department of Emergency Management, or
5 in his or her absence the Chief Financial Officer of the Department of Emergency
6 Management or the Deputy Director of the Division of Emergency Services, or the Chief
7 Financial Officer of the Division of Emergency Services, or the Controller of the City and
8 County of San Francisco to execute for and on behalf of the City and County of San
9 Francisco, any applications necessary for the purpose of obtaining financial assistance.
