My name is angellynn tam and I am the Youth Intimate Partner Violence Prevention Coordinator at San Francisco Asian Women's Shelter (SFAWS). I am writing to express my strong support for BOS File No. 260407, the resolution in recognizing April 2026 as National Sexual Assault and Prevention Month.

At SFAWS, we see firsthand the critical importance of city-wide recognition. Formally acknowledging this month sends a powerful message to survivors of all ages -- especially our youth between ages 12-25 -- that they are seen, supported, and their

However, recognition is only the first step. Prevention work is rooted in education. To truly address sexual assault and the many forms of violence, we must ensure that educators and community organizations have the resources to foster long-term awareness and safety.
