ORDINANCE NO.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Purpose. The City charges a fee for recreation programs that pays for a portion of the recreation programs operating costs. The City's General Fund covers the rest of the operating costs, as well as the cost of a scholarship program to help residents who are experiencing financial hardship to access the recreation programs. This ordinance would increase the recreation fees to cover a greater portion of the recreation program operating costs, albeit still below the amount needed to fully cover all costs, so that the City's General Fund can continue to cover the costs of the scholarship programs.

 Section 2. Article 12 of the Park Code is hereby amended by revising Section 12.44, to read as follows:

Section 4. Scope of Ordinance.

- (a) In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under the official title of the ordinance.
- (b) The various codified fees presented as existing Code text in Section 2 of this ordinance do not necessarily reflect the fees that are currently applicable. Pursuant to Park Code Section 12.20, the Controller adjusts fees on an annual basis to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index. This ordinance is not intended to invalidate any adjustments under Section 12.20 that the Controller has previously approved.
