
18 WHEREAS, literacy empowers people to more fully engage in the democratic,

21 access to knowledge tools, now therefore be it


22 RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Public Library, be authorized to accept and expend

operations of the Project Read program to promote literacy among non-reading English speaking adults in our community.






