

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - Department of Health and Human Services,
2 Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration - California Department of
3 Health Care Services - Crisis Care Mobile Units (CCMU) Program - \$1,977,500]

4 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and**
5 **expend a grant in the amount of \$17,500 from the Department of Health and Human**
6 **Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration through the**
7 **California Department of Health Care Services, together with a grant in the amount of**
8 **\$1,960,000 from the California Department of Health Care Services for a total grant**
9 **amount of \$1,977,500, to participate in a program, entitled “Crisis Care Mobile Units**
10 **(CCMU) Program,” for the period of September 15, 2021, through June 30, 2025.**

12 WHEREAS, Department of Health and Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental
13 Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), through the California Department of Health Care
14 Services (DHCS) as a pass-through entity, has agreed to fund the Department of Public
15 Health (DPH) in the amount of \$17,500, and the DHCS has agreed to fund the DPH in the
16 amount of \$1,960,000 for a total grant amount of \$1,977,500, to participate in a program,
17 entitled “Crisis Care Mobile Units (CCMU) Program,” for the period of September 15, 2021,
18 through June 30, 2025; and

19 WHEREAS, The mission of the San Francisco Comprehensive Crisis Services (CCS)
20 is to provide compassionate, culturally appropriate, trauma-informed interventions that bring
21 safety and foster resiliency, strength and hope for individuals, families, and communities in
22 crisis; and

23 WHEREAS, CCS will significantly expand the quality, scope, and impact of our existing
24 CCMU program by, among other activities: a) adding staff to provide continuous quality
25 improvement to support mobile crisis calls; b) acquiring new vehicles to increase the time

1 spent in the field by mobile teams; c) upgrading existing phone systems to improve
2 communication quality and facilitate automated data collection; d) purchasing laptops and
3 tablets for telehealth and remote documentation in the field; and e) providing de-escalation
4 trainings to clinical staff; and

5 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment; and

6 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received
7 the notice of award on October 5, 2021, for a project start date of September 15, 2021; and

8 WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on
9 program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in
11 the grant budget; and, be it

12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant
13 in the amount of \$17,500 from the SAMHSA through DHCS, and \$1,960,000 from the DHCS
14 for a total grant amount of \$1,977,500; and, be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
16 expend the grant funds pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1; and, be it

17 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
18 Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the Grant Agreement being fully
20 executed by all parties, the Director of Health shall provide a copy to the Clerk of the Board of
21 Supervisors for inclusion in the official file.
