

1 [Resolution urging the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency to make all enrolled
2 San Francisco High School students eligible for their youth rate.]

3 **Resolution urging the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) to**
4 **make all enrolled San Francisco High School students eligible for their youth rate and**
5 **to allow all current student identification cards as valid forms of identification.**

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7 WHEREAS, The SFMTA currently allows youth between the ages of 5 and 17 to ride
8 for a fare of \$0.35; and

9 WHEREAS, The SFMTA youth rate is designed to encourage youth riders to use
10 public transportation and to afford public transportation; and,

11 WHEREAS, There are hundreds of enrolled San Francisco high school students that
12 become 18 years of age during the course of their senior year and no longer qualify for the
13 youth fare; and

14 WHEREAS, Increasing the fare by more than four times for enrolled high school
15 students can both decrease the use of public transportation and lead to instances of fare
16 evasion; and

17 WHEREAS, San Francisco high school students are provided a valid student
18 identification at the beginning of each year; and

19 WHEREAS, The SFMTA can apply its past experience with the “Class Pass” and
20 disabled fare mechanisms in limiting fraud and abuse; and

21 WHEREAS, All enrolled San Francisco high school student should be allowed to keep
22 their youth status through their graduation from high school: and now, therefore, be it

23 **RESOLVED**, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the SFMTA to allow
24 all enrolled San Francisco high school students to use public transportation at the current
25 youth fare; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the
2 SFMTA allows valid student identification cards issued by San Francisco high schools to be
3 used as proof of their age and high school enrollment status.
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
