

1 [Jail Food Services]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the Sheriff's Department to enter into a contract for jail food**  
4 **services which will require anticipated expenditures by the City and County of more**  
5 **than ten million dollars over a four year period.**

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7 WHEREAS, Section 9.118 (b) of the Charter of the City and County of San Francisco  
8 requires that contracts or agreements entered into by a department, board or commission  
9 requiring anticipated expenditures of ten million dollars, shall be subject to approval of the  
10 Board of Supervisors by resolution; and,

11 WHEREAS, the Controller has certified that jail food services can practically be  
12 performed by a private contractor at a lower cost than if work were performed by city  
13 employees at budgeted levels pursuant to Charter Section 10.104.15; and,

14 WHEREAS, On October 8, 2004, the Sheriff's Department issued a Request for  
15 Proposals for Food Service Operations at the County Jails and as a result of that selection  
16 process, identified Aramark Correctional Services to receive a contract in the amount of  
17 \$15,227,132 over four years to provide jail food services; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That pursuant to Section 9.118 (b) of the Charter, this Board of  
19 Supervisors hereby approves this resolution authorizing the Sheriff's Department to enter into  
20 a contract for jail food services which will require anticipated expenditures by the City and  
21 County of more than ten million dollars over a four year period.

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
