5 WHEREAS, President Clinton has repeatedly demonstrated his commitment to end
6 discrimination against gay and lesbian Americans; and,

7 WHEREAS, In 1998, President Clinton signed an Executive Order that amends federal
8 equal employment opportunity policy to prohibit discrimination in the federal civilian workforce
9 based on sexual discrimination; and,

10 WHEREAS, The federal government has also banned discrimination based on sexual
11 orientation in the granting of security clearances; and,

12 WHEREAS, The Clinton Administration is also working to pass the Employment
13 Nondiscrimination Act, which would prohibit most private employers from firing workers solely
14 because of their sexual orientation; and,

15 WHEREAS, On June 11, 1999, President Clinton proclaimed June 1999 as Gay and
16 Lesbian Pride Month and encouraged Americans to observe the month with appropriate
17 programs, ceremonies, and activities that celebrate our country's diversity; now, therefore, be
18 it

19 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
20 commends President Clinton for proclaiming June 1999 as Gay and Lesbian Pride Month.
