Centers, and Environmental Youth Service Centers that are within immediate proximity of a

neighborhood that has been identified by the Department as having: a.) critical lack of parks

and/or open space and/or b.) deteriorated park facilities that are in an area of significant

poverty, unemployment and shortage of services for youth; and

WHEREAS, in May of 2002 the San Francisco Recreation and Park Department submitted a grant application to the Murray-Hayden Urban Parks and Youth Service Program

for the for renovation of the play area, clubhouse and tennis courts at the Helen Wills

Playground in the amount of \$1,500,000; and

WHEREAS, Helen Wills Playground, built in 1915, is located on the corner of

Broadway and Larkin Street in a neighborhood with a critical lack of parks and open space as

well as deteriorated park facilities; and

23 WHEREAS, Helen Wills Playground provides many recreation programs including:

24 Tiny Tot Program for infants and toddlers; pre school playgroups; after school homework for

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children and teens; organized field trips; spring and summer baseball leagues; and other

2 sports for teens and adults such as basketball, table tennis, tennis and football; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Recreation and Park Commission applied for a grant in the amount of \$1,500,000 from the Murray-Hayden Urban Parks and Youth Service Program for the for renovation of the play area, clubhouse and tennis courts at the Helen Wills Playground on May 16, 2002 under resolution #0205-012; and

WHEREAS, this project would eliminate toxic materials, optimize the park's facilities for all age groups, and make the park facilities and programs more accessible and enjoyable to all; and

WHEREAS, The Bond Act delegates to the California Department of Parks and Recreation the responsibility for the administration of the Grant Programs, setting up necessary procedures; and

WHEREAS, on October 23, 2002, the California Department of Parks and Recreation offered a grant in the amount of \$1,500,000 to the San Francisco Recreation and Park Department for renovation of the play area, clubhouse and tennis courts at the Helen Wills Playground; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Recreation and Park Department will enter into an agreement with the California Department of Parks and Recreation for the subject project;
