2 AMENDING PART II, CHAPTER V, OF THE SAN FRANCISCO MUNICIPAL CODE (HEALTH CODE) BY
 3 AMENDING SECTION 128 THEREOF, TO FIX PATIENT RATES FOR SERVICES FURNISHED BY
 4 CITY AND COUNTY HEALTHCARE INSTITUTIONS, RETROACTIVELY TO JULY 1, 1998.

6 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

7 Section 1. Part II, Chapter V of the San Francisco Municipal Code (Health Code) is hereby
 8 amended by amending Section 128, to read as follows:

9 Sec. 128 PATIENT RATES. The Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
 10 does hereby determine and fix the proper reasonable amounts to be charged to persons for services
 11 furnished by City and County institutions as follows, which rates shall be effective for services delivered
 12 as of ((July 1, 1997)) July 1, 1998.


