WHEREAS, The San Francisco Public Library has a goal of providing free and equal access to knowledge tools-both traditional and electronic, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Public Library, be authorized to accept and expend \$18,000 awarded by the California State Library, InfoPeople Project as part of the Federal Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA), to purchase Internet capable computers and

accessories for the Visitation Valley, North Beach and Anza branch libraries and that indirect costs be waived as no indirect costs are allowed in this grant, all monies to be used for actual purchase of equipment, supplies and connection fees.
