FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of the Environment Department, or the Director's designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the Environment Department, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, all grant documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments and requests

for payment, necessary to secure grant funds and implement the approved grant project(s); and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That these authorizations are effective for five years from the date of adoption of this resolution.
