AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH, HIV RESEARCH SECTION, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$896,321 WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, SAN FRANCISCO, THE PRIMARY CONTRACTOR, TO FUND THE ZIMBABWE-SAN FRANCISCO HIV PREVENTION TRIALS UNIT OF THE HIV PREVENTION TRIALS NETWORK; RETROACTIVE TO JULY 1, 2000.

WHEREAS, The University of California, San Francisco, has received funds from the National Institutes of Health for a project entitled The Zimbabwe-San Francisco HIV Prevention Trials Unit; and,

WHEREAS, The University of California, San Francisco, as the primary contractor has requested that the Department of Public Health, HIV Research Section, enter into an agreement to participate in this project by continuing to conduct a study with high-risk HIV uninfected men who have sex with men and provide local oversight and implementation of the protocol for this project; and,

WHEREAS, The University of California, San Francisco, has agreed to reimburse the Department of Public Health, HIV Research Section, in the amount of \$896,321 under the terms of this agreement; and

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds, The University of California, San Francisco, requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. \_\_\_\_001712\_\_\_\_; and,

WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$96,423; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Health is hereby authorized to enter into a subcontract in the amount of \$896,321 with The University of California, San Francisco, the primary contractor, during the period covered by this Agreement; retroactive to July 1, 2000; and, be it
