[State Grant – Domestic Violence Prosecution]

AUTHORIZING RETROACTIVELY THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND EXPEND FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT GRANTED BY THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR A PROJECT ENTITLED "SPOUSAL ABUSER PROSECUTION PROGRAM" FOR THE TWELVE MONTHS OF A GIVEN FISCAL YEAR, AND WAIVING APPLICABLE INDIRECT COSTS DUE TO FUNDING CONSTRAINTS.

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco desires to continue a project entitled the "Spousal Abuser Prosecution Program" (SAPP), to be funded, in part, from funds made available through Chapter 599, 1994 Statutes, administered by the California Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, The project enhances the capacity of the District Attorney's Office to prosecute domestic violence offenses; now, therefore; be it

RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized to execute on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Award Agreement for Spousal Abuser Prosecution Program purposes, including any extensions, augmentations and amendments thereof; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That any grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant local funds that would, in the absence of the Spousal Abuser Prosecution Program, be made available to support the prosecution of individuals accused of domestic violence; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco, through the Office of the District Attorney, shall provide no less than the twenty percent required match for the project; and be it


1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is agreed that any liability arising out of the performance
2 of the Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility
3 of the grantee and the implementing agency. The State of California and Department of Justice
4 disclaim responsibility for any such liability; and be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That indirect costs are waived due to funding constraints;
6 and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney of the City and County of San Francisco
8 is retroactively authorized to apply for, accept and expend funds made available through the
9 California Department of Justice for a project entitled "Spousal Abuser Prosecution Program" for
10 twelve months of a given period.


