RESOLUTION NO. 534-99

1 [Apply-Accept-Expend State Bike Lane Account Grant]

2 AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKING AND TRAFFIC TO RETROACTIVELY
3 APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$79,632 FROM
4 THE FY 1997-1998 STATE BICYCLE LANE ACCOUNT FOR CONSTRUCTION AND
5 OPERATION OF AN ATTENDED BICYCLE PARKING FACILITY AT A SAN FRANCISCO^{BART}
6 TRANSIT STATION AND WAIVING INDIRECT COSTS.

7 WHEREAS, The California Bicycle Transportation Act (Streets and
8 Highways Code Sec. 891.4 and 893), provides for the disbursement of
9 funds for projects that improve the safety and convenience of bicycle
10 commuters; and,

11 WHEREAS, AB1020 was signed into law, effective January 1, 1998,
12 increasing the Bike Lane Account to \$1,000,000 for fiscal years 1998,
13 1999, and 2000; and; and,

14 WHEREAS, The San Francisco County Transportation Authority has
15 granted \$76,000 of Bay Area Air Quality Management District
16 Transportation Fund for Clean Air Program Manger funds for this
17 project,

18 WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic has identified
19 \$79,632 in additional funding needed to construct and operate an
20 attended bicycle parking facility at a San Francisco^{BART}/transit station;
21 and,

22 WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic will require a
23 total of \$155,632 to construct and operate an attended bicycle
24 parking facility at a San Francisco^{BART}/transit station; and,

1 WHEREAS, The Parking and Traffic Commission adopted Resolution
2 No. 123-99-PTC at its meeting of March 2, 1999 authorizing the
3 Executive Director of the Department of Parking and Traffic or his
4 designee, to apply for, accept and expend \$79,632 from the FY 1997-
5 1998 State Bicycle Lane Account to construct and operate an attended
6 bicycle parking facility at a San Francisco transit station; now,
7 therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, That the Department of Parking And Traffic be
9 retroactively authorized to apply for, accept and expend a grant in
10 the amount of \$79,632 from the State Bicycle Lane Account for
11 construction and operation of an attended bicycle parking facility at
12 a San Francisco transit station located on BART property, waiving indirect costs; and be it

13 FURTHER RESOLVED, That charges for indirect costs be waived to
14 maximize the funds available for program delivery; and be it


15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That although the City has incurred no legal
16 obligation, the Board of Supervisors does hereby ratify the action
17 previously taken.

18 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the grant funds constitute a gift to BART, and if
19 revenues generated by this project are not sufficient to sustain the project's on-
20 going operations, the City will not be responsible for the continued operation and
21 maintenance of this bicycle and transit program



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
