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AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO TO ACCEPT RETROACTIVELY, AND EXPEND FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF EIGHT HUNDRED SEVENTY EIGHT THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED TWENTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$ 878,925.00), EXCLUDING INDIRECT COSTS NOT ALLOWED UNDER THIS PROGRAM, FOR A PROJECT ENTITLED THE "COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES – MAKING OFFICER REDEPLOYMENT EFFECTIVE – '98 (COPS-MORE '98)", MADE AVAILABLE FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE'S OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES, AND AGREEING TO PROVIDE A CASH MATCH IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED NINETY-TWO THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY SIX DOLLARS (\$ 292,976.00).


WHEREAS, the Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco desires to undertake a certain project designated COPS-MORE – '98 to be funded in part from funds made available through the U.S. Department of Justice - Office of Community Oriented Policing Services – (DOJ/COPS); now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco is authorized to execute on behalf of the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco the attached Grant Award Agreement including any extensions, amendments thereof; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is agreed that any liability arising out of the  
2 performance of this Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages,  
3 shall be the responsibility of the grantee and the authorizing agency. The United States  
4 Government and DOJ disclaim responsibility for any such liability; and, be it

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6 FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used  
7 to supplant expenditures controlled by this body; and, be it

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10 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police of the City and County of San  
11 Francisco is authorized to retroactively accept, and expend funds in the amount of Eight  
12 Hundred Seventy Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$ 878,925.00),  
13 excluding indirect costs not allowed under this program, for a project entitled "COPS-  
14 MORE '98" made available from the United States Department of Justice's Office of  
15 Community Oriented Policing Services, and agreeing to provide a cash match in the  
16 amount of Two Hundred Ninety Two Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy Six Dollars (\$


