

1 [Proposition J Contract/Certification of Specified Contracted-Out Services for Department of
2 Elections]

3 **Resolution concurring with the Controller's certification that services can be performed**
4 **by private contractor for a lower cost than similar work performed by City and County**
5 **employees for absentee voter ballot distribution services for Department of Elections.**

6 WHEREAS, The Electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed
7 Proposition J in November 1976, allowing City and County Departments to contract with
8 private companies for specific services which can be performed for a lower cost than similar
9 work by City and County employees (Charter Section 10.104.15); and,

10 WHEREAS, The Controller has determined that the award of a contract for the services
11 listed below to a private contractor will achieve substantial cost savings for the City; and,

12 WHEREAS, The Controller's certification, which confirms that said services can be
13 performed at lower costs to the City and County by a private contractor than by employees of
14 the City and County, is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 070885
15 which is hereby declared to be part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; now, therefore
16 be it;

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby concurs with the Controller's
18 certification and approves the Proposition J Resolution concerning the award of a contract to
19 a private contractor for the services listed below for the period of July 1, 2007 through
20 June 30, 2008.
