

1 [Accept-Expend Grant B Public Defender]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the Office of the Public Defender to accept and expend a grant**  
4 **in the amount of \$25,000 from The San Francisco Foundation for a senior clerk**  
5 **position and consulting services to support the implementation of the Safe**  
6 **Communities Reentry Council’s strategic plan.**

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8 WHEREAS, the Public Defender of the City and County of San Francisco provides  
9 leadership as co-chair of the San Francisco Safe Communities Reentry Council; and,

10 WHEREAS, the mission of the San Francisco Safe Communities Reentry Council is to  
11 support the safe and successful reentry of formerly incarcerated individuals to San Francisco  
12 communities; and,

13 WHEREAS, the San Francisco Safe Communities Reentry Council is a broad based  
14 coalition of relevant community, government, and private stakeholders necessary to  
15 effectively improve programs and policies related to prisoner reentry; and,

16 WHEREAS, the San Francisco Safe Communities Reentry Council has developed a 2-  
17 year strategic plan to improve the coordination, capacity, and quality of reentry services in  
18 San Francisco; and,

19 WHEREAS, there is a need for implementation tools including common definitions of  
20 outcome measures and an inventory of existing reentry services City-wide;

21 WHEREAS, a temporary Senior Clerk will develop common definitions of key outcome  
22 measures in partnership with key governmental and community partners through an analysis  
23 of existing research and practice; this grant does not require an ASO amendment, and,

24 WHEREAS, an outside consultant will develop a reentry program model matrix in  
25 conjunction with all relevant stakeholders providing reentry services and interventions in San  
Francisco; and,

1 WHEREAS, the Public Defender=s Office has been selected to receive a grant on  
 2 behalf of the Safe Communities Reentry Council in the amount of \$25,000 from The San  
 3 Francisco Foundation for the purposes of developing implementation tools related to  
 4 outcomes and inventory of services, \$20,000 for an outside consultant to develop a reentry  
 5 program model matrix and \$5,000 for a temporary senior clerk to develop shared definitions  
 6 of outcome measures, for 12 months; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the Public Defender of the City and County of San Francisco is  
 8 authorized to enter into the attached grant award agreement on behalf of the City; and

9 RESOLVED, That none of the grant funds will be expended on indirect costs; and

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Public Defender is authorized to accept and expend  
 11 \$5,000 of the grant funds for a temporary senior clerk position, classification 1406, dedicated  
 12 to developing outcome measures, \$20,000 for consulting services to develop reentry program  
 13 model matrix; and be it

14 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position  
 15 funded under this agreement as AG@ or grant-funded positions which would terminate when  
 16 the agreement expires.
