10 participation of persons in all of its activities and in the full range of human endeavor without
11 regard to race, color, sex, disability, affectional or sexual orientation, age, or national origin
12 and without requiring adherence to any particular interpretation of religion or to any particular
13 religious belief or creed; and,

14 WHEREAS, The First Unitarian Universalist Society of San Francisco welcomes all
15 seekers including Christians, Jews, humanists, agnostics, Pagans, Buddhists, Hindus,
16 Taoists, straights, gays, lesbians, couples, singles, and the young and old; and,

17 WHEREAS, The First Unitarian Universalist Society of San Francisco supports several
18 social justice-related projects in San Francisco including the Alternative Family Project, the
19 Bethesda Project, the San Francisco Food Bank, Habitat for Humanity San Francisco, School
20 of the Americas Watch West, Martin's Helpers, and Promise the Children; and,

21 WHEREAS, The First Unitarian Universalist Society of San Francisco held its first
22 meeting in the City on October 20, 1850; and,

23 WHEREAS, The First Unitarian Universalist Society of San Francisco will celebrate its
24 150th anniversary with a church service and dinner on Friday , October 20 and with parties,

2 of its first 150 years; now, therefore, be it
