WAIVING FEES TO BE CHARGED FOR CROWD CONTROL AND RE-ROUTING TRANSIT

LINES IN CONNECTION WITH THE PINK SATURDAY PARTY ON JUNE 27, 1998.

WHEREAS, The Sisters of Perpetual Indulgence, Inc. ("the Sisters") organized the Pink Saturday Party ("the party") held in the Castro on June 27, 1998; and,

WHEREAS, The Sisters collected only voluntary donations from party-goers for distribution to non-profit, community-based charitable organizations; and,

WHEREAS, The associated costs of crowd control and re-routing transit lines for the party have been calculated at \$2,500 for the Police Department and \$1,400 for the Municipal Railway; and,

WHEREAS, The Sisters do not benefit from holding the party but rather have aided the City by helping keep order at an event that would occur spontaneously without their involvement; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the Police Department and Municipal Railway fees that would otherwise be charged to the Sisters in connection with the Pink Saturday Party of June 27, 1998.
