11 NO PARKING ANYTIME - ESTABLISH

12 San Bruno Avenue, west side, from north terminus north of 18th Street to 50 feet
13 southerly (50-foot zone, replacing and extending existing zone)

14 UNMETERED MOTORCYCLE PARKING - ESTABLISH

15 16th Street, north side, from 8th Street to 35 feet easterly (35-foot zone,
16 accommodating 10 motorcycle spaces)




