[Grant Agreement Amendment - Compass Family Services - Family Housing Ladder - Not to

Family Services and the Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing ("HSH") for services and subsidy administration for the family housing ladder program; extending the grant term by 24 months from June 30, 2024, for a total term of October 1, 2022, through June 30, 2026; increasing the agreement amount by \$7,038,650 for a total amount not to exceed \$13,104,997; and authorizing HSH to enter into any amendments or other modifications to the agreement that do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities, or materially decrease the benefits to the City and are necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of the agreement.

WHEREAS, The mission of the Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing ("HSH" or "Department") is to prevent homelessness when possible and make homelessness rare, brief, and one-time in the City and County of San Francisco ("the City") through the provision of coordinated, compassionate, and high-quality services; and

WHEREAS, HSH's housing ladder program offers opportunities for people who live in HSH permanent supportive housing and no longer need intensive services to transition into a more independent housing setting that has a lower level of supportive services; and

WHEREAS. In the family housing ladder program, households move into units on the private rental market and receive a subsidy and fewer supportive services; and

WHEREAS. The nonprofit provider Compass Family Services ("Compass") has extensive experience operating supportive housing for families; and

WHEREAS, HSH entered into a grant agreement ("Agreement") in 2022 for the term October 1, 2022, through June 30, 2024, in an amount not to exceed \$6,066,347 with

Compass to provide housing location services, subsidy administration, and minimal case management for 70 families annually through the housing ladder program ("Program"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors ("Clerk") in File No. 240338; and

WHEREAS, In fiscal year 2022-23 the Program served 39 households as the program ramped up; and

WHEREAS, The proposed first amendment ("Amendment") to the Agreement would extend the Agreement for Compass to continue to provide these services by 24 months to June 30, 2026, and increase the not to exceed amount by \$7,038,650 for a total amount not to exceed \$13,104,997; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors approved using Proposition C (2018) (Gross Receipts Tax for Homelessness Services) ("Prop C"), passed by San Francisco voters in November 2018, to fund the Our City, Our Home ("OCOH") Fund, in order to expand and complement existing funding and strategic efforts to prevent and end homelessness for San Franciscans, including housing programming; and

WHEREAS, 100% of this agreement is funded with Prop C dollars; and WHEREAS, A copy of the Amendment is on file with the Clerk in File No. 240338, substantially in final form, with all material terms and conditions included, and only remains to be executed by the parties upon approval of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, The Amendment requires Board of Supervisors approval under Section 9.118 of the Charter; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Executive Director of HSH ("Director") or their designee to execute the Amendment to extend the current term of October 1, 2022, through June 30, 2024, to October 1, 2022, through June 30, 2026, and to increase the not to exceed amount by \$7,038,650 for a total amount not to exceed \$13,104,997; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director or their designee to enter into any amendments or modifications to the Amendment, prior to its final execution by all parties, that HSH determines, in consultation with the City Attorney, do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City or materially decrease the benefits to the City, are necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of the grant, and are in compliance with all applicable laws; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the Amendment being executed by all parties, HSH shall submit to the Clerk a completely executed copy for inclusion in File No. 240338; this requirement and obligation resides with HSH, and is for the purposes of having a complete file only, and in no manner affects the validity of the approved agreement.
