

1 [Grant to support the National HIV Behavioral Surveillance project.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept**
4 **and expend retroactively a new grant from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) in the**
5 **amount of \$418,225 to support the “National HIV Behavioral Surveillance” project, and**
6 **to enter into a subcontract with the Public Health Foundation Enterprises (PHFE) in the**
7 **amount of \$53,723; for the period of January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008.**

9 WHEREAS, DPH – HIV Epidemiology Section received a grant award from the CDC to
10 monitor HIV prevalence, incidence, related risk behavior and utilization of prevention service
11 among men who have sex with men (MSM), injection drug users (IDU) and heterosexuals
12 living in high-risk areas through the “National HIV Behavioral Surveillance” project; and,

13 WHEREAS, The CDC has awarded DPH \$418,225 (total \$1,254,675), from January 1,
14 2008 through December 31, 2008 and will extend the project two additional years (through
15 December 31, 2010) if funds are available and satisfactory progress is made; and,

16 WHEREAS, DPH will subcontract with PHFE for the same time period in the amount of
17 \$47,967 plus \$5,756 (12% contingency) for a total of \$53,723 per year; and,

18 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the CDC requires the City to
19 enter into an agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
20 Board of Supervisors in File No. 080313; which is hereby declared to be a part of this
21 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

22 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required, as funds will support five existing
23 positions, including Epidemiologist II (#2803) at .20 FTE, Health Program Coordinator III
24 (#2593) at .45 FTE, Health Worker III (#2587) at 1 FTE, and two Health Worker I (#2585) at
25 .50 FTE each; and,

1 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of
2 \$41,281; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a grant
4 in the amount of \$418,225 from the CDC; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend
6 retroactively the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1;
7 and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
9 agreement on behalf of the City.
