LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Administrative Code - Reentry Council; Pretrial Services Seat]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to add a seat to the Reentry Council, to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors, designated for a representative of the entity responsible for the administration of pretrial services involving alternatives to incarceration.

Existing Law

Existing law establishes the Reentry Council to coordinate local efforts to support adults exiting San Francisco County Jail, San Francisco juvenile justice system out-of-home placements, the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation facilities, and the United States Federal Bureau of Prison facilities. Existing law authorizes the Mayor and Board of Supervisors to appoint persons to the Council and designate officers.

Amendments to Current Law

This ordinance would add an additional member, to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors, designated for a representative of the entity responsible for the administration of pretrial services involving alternatives to incarceration.

Background Information

Currently, pretrial services involving alternatives to incarceration are administered by a private entity under the San Francisco Sheriff Office's Pretrial Incarceration Alternatives contract.
