## (ADVERTISING CONTRACT ON MUNI VEHICLES)

AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PURCHASING AND THE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES TO EXECUTE A FIVE- YEAR CONTRACT WITH TRANSPORTATION DISPLAYS INCORPORATED FOR THE SALE OF ADVERTISING SPACE ON MUNI REVENUE VEHICLES AND PLATFORM DISPLAY SIGN SYSTEM AND MINIMUM ANNUAL GUARANTEES OF \$45,150,000.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Public Transportation Commission currently has an advertising agreement providing the Municipal Railway with a significant amount of advertising revenue each year; and,

WHEREAS, This agreement will expire on June 30, 1999; and,

WHEREAS, It is in the best interests of the City to seek competitive proposals to ensure that the company representing the Municipal Railway's advertising program will achieve the highest possible performance standards; and,

WHEREAS, The Public Transportation Commission authorized the solicitation of proposals from companies specializing in the management of transit advertising programs; and,

WHEREAS, A selection process was established to fairly and objectively evaluate proposals, with the intent of selecting the most qualified company to represent the Municipal Railway's interests; and,

WHEREAS, A specially appointed selection committee heard oral presentations for each of the proposals, and also requested a Best and Final Offer for each of the proposals; and,

WHEREAS, The committee has reviewed the Best and Final Offers, and has recommended to the Public Transportation Commission that it execute a new five-year Transit Advertising Agreement with Transportation Displays Incorporated (TDI); and,

WHEREAS, TDI's Best and Final Offer offers a minimum total annual aggregate of revenue and services of \$45,150,000, including total minimum guarantees of \$42,575,000 for advertising on Muni revenue vehicles during the 5-year term of the agreement, an annual minimum guarantee of \$105,000 for advertising on the Muni Metro Platform Display Sign System, \$60,000 of Muni advertising on

Bay Area electronic or print media each year, and \$350,000 of broadcast time each year for Muni on premier San Francisco radio and television media; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, That the Director of Purchasing and the Director of Administrative Services is authorized to execute the Transit Advertising Agreement with TDI for a term of five years, from July 1, 1999, through June 30, 2004, with a minimum total annual aggregate of revenue and services of \$45,150,000.
