

1 [Grant to evaluate a mobile intervention to a late night population of men who have sex with
2 men to reduce their risk of HIV/STD and substance use harm.]

4 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health, AIDS Office,**
5 **(SFDPH, AIDS) to accept retroactively and expend a grant in the amount of \$106,788**
6 **from the Regents of the University of California San Francisco, Universitywide AIDS**
7 **Research Program (UCSF,UARP) to evaluate a mobile intervention to a late night**
8 **population of men who have sex with men to reduce their risk of HIV/STD and**
9 **substance use harm and to enter into an agreement for the use of these funds; for the**
10 **period of February 1, 2004 to July 31, 2005.**

11 WHEREAS, SFDPH, AIDS has applied for and been awarded a grant from UCSF,
12 UARP in the amount of \$106,788 to conduct a program entitled Late Night Breakfast Buffet,
13 and,

14 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, UCSF,UARP requires the City
15 to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
16 Board of Supervisors in File No._____, which is hereby declared to be a part of
17 this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

18 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$6,788; and,

19 WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors
20 because the Department did not receive the UCSF,UARP subcontract until February 3, 2004;
21 and,

22 WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds
23 may be placed automatically on consent agendas in committee, as they are usually

1 considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure
2 of grant funding; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That SFDPH, AIDS is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and
4 expend a grant in the amount of \$106,788 from UCSF,UARP; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH, AIDS is hereby authorized to accept and
6 expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement
7 pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
9 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions
11 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when
12 the agreement expires.
